DCU St Patrick's Campus, Drumcondra

Some of you may be travelling to the Conference by car and the following are the arrangements in relation to campus parking. [Also attached is a copy of a map for the DCU St Patrick's Campus for convenience. Main buildings are numbered.]

GETTING TO THE CAMPUS

If you come into Drumcondra from the M50 (i.e. heading towards the city centre), watch for the following landmarks immediately before SPC. You'll pass The Skylon Hotel and then Lidl (both on your right) and the Cat & Cage pub on your left. The Main Entrance to SPC for vehicles is the next right after the Cat & Cage (through the traffic lights). It is a wide, double-gated entrance with a granite stone facade.

If you come into Drumcondra from the city (i.e. heading towards the airport), watch for the following landmarks immediately before SPC. You'll pass Kennedy's pub and Fagan's pub (both on your left) before you cross the bridge and then you'll see the Millmount House pub, also on your left. The Main Entrance to SPC is the next left and is the wide, double-gated entrance with a granite stone facade.

ON THE CAMPUS

On coming in the Main Entrance (beside No. 18 on the map), proceed straight ahead, passing the College Chapel (No. 17) on your right and Merville House (No. 16) on your left. The Sports Complex will be straight ahead. Make a sharp left which will bring you down behind Merville House and Clonmacnoise House, where there is ample parking. There is further parking up behind the Sports Complex (No. 8).

Parking will be free in the following areas:

- (1) Main Staff Car Park in front of Block A (No. 1)
- (2) In the bays behind the Merville and Clonmacnoise Halls of Residence (Nos 16 & 10)
- (3) Behind the Sports Complex (No. 8)

DO NOT park in the Visitors' Bay (in front of No. 10) or in the Car Park at the Teachers' Centre (beside No. 11), as there is a risk of clamping. (You will see these two areas as you come in the Main Entrance.)

Proceed to the entrance of Block A (No. 1) and follow the signs for ECIS Conference. If you are walking from your accommodation or coming by public transport, you may also access the conference rooms via the upper entrance at the Cregan Library (No. 7), entering via Block F. Signage will guide you.

Conference venue is the Second Floor of Block D [D203, D204, D205 & D210]
